May God continue to provide you and your families with more wisdom, strength, and good health in His service. By God's great assistance, I and my family are enjoying good health and continue to do His work

I do apologize for taking so long to write you. Brothers and Sisters, I am very sorry for the length of time that has elapsed without my mission reports to you. Please, I ask for your forgiveness, and I make every effort to improve in that area.

During January and February 2011, I visited eight different congregations and worshiped with them on Sundays. They were all doing well. Among the eight congregations where I worshiped, one of them was outside Bui Division. That was Dschang, a French-speaking congregation in the Western Region. Sister Rosine is going to University there now, and I go there and write some exams necessary for my own studies. I hope to get a degree and she is working to get another degree herself.

As for Kumbo Christian Bible School, on January 4<sup>th</sup> classes resumed for the second quarter, both in the English and French sections. By March 24<sup>th</sup>, final examinations will begin, ending on the 30<sup>th</sup>. There will be a closing ceremony on March 31<sup>st</sup> (graduation is only every third year).

So far as public preaching is concerned, since November 2010 I have been preaching weekly at Kimar, Rondop, and Ndjorwe. With the assistance of two brothers, Robert Tandong and Joshua Banyee, we are going to some of these places for face to-face contacts now. We are meeting with some of our initial contacts in their homes and discuss with them personally. I beg you to include them in your prayers so that they will obey the Gospel. We did have one baptism at Ndjorwe this week!

I am still handling the Moral Education classes at the Government Bilingual High School in the French section. They are going on well in this 2010 to 2011 academic Year.

We are glad that brother Paul Kee and Sister Janet came back to Cameroon safely. On January 5<sup>th</sup>, after one month in the U.S. We thank God for that.

Rosine and I continue to thank you for your constant financial support and spiritual support for the Lord's work in Cameroon. May God bless your efforts and continue also to provide for the glory of His name and kingdom. We will also continue to be praying for you. May the Almighty God continue to add you more power in your efforts for your service to Him.
